

FROM VOLUME OF COMMON RECORDS, NEVIS, 1777—1779, p. 468.

Indenture dated 18 March 1778, between Robert Pemberton the younger of the parish of St. John, Nevis, Esq., and Elizabeth his wife of one part, and James Smith of the parish of St. Thomas, Nevis, Esq., of the other part.

In consideration of the sum of 5/- paid by the said James Smith, the said Robert and Elizabeth sell to the said James Smith a parcel of land lying in the parish of St James (about 50 acres) formerly in possession of Robert Pemberton of the said Island, deceased, and father of the said Robert Pemberton, party to these presents.
