Will of Robert Pemberton, senr., of parish of St. George, Nevis, Esq., dated 21 June 1782.

Desires to be buried at the Parish Church of St. George, at discretion of Executrix.

All estate, real and personal, not otherwise devised, is left to his dear wife Bridget Pemberton, her heirs and assigns, on trust, after payment of debts and funeral expenses, etc., to pay to each of his children, except his eldest son Robert, £500, *viz.* :—

To daughter Bridget, one year after his decease.	
" " Elizabeth, two years " "	
" " Christian	
" son Roger Bridgewater	} At respective ages of 21 years or day of marriage, whichever shall first happen.
" " William Henry	
" daughter Mary Butler	
" " Louisa	

Also various negroes to each of the above children.

To wife Bridget Pemberton the use of dwelling-house, out-offices, furniture, and plate for life, as well as annual interest of legacies to children till they respectively fall due.

To son Robert £100 per annum for maintenance and education during his minority. Said Robert made Residuary Legatee.

Wife Bridget appointed sole Executrix.
