Later his wife, Elizabeth, and three children, Elizabeth fifteen, Sarah ten, and John seven years old, sailed in ship "Francis." of Ipswich, and joined him in Watertown, Mass., in 1634. He died Oct. 8, 1662, was one of the first settlers of the town.

THOMAS 3 HAMMOND (William 2, Thomas 1.) b. Sept. 17, 1618, m. Hannah Gross, and d. in Watertown, Dec. 10, 1655. to whom was born Thomas July 11, 1656, about seven months after the death of his father; the mother died March 22, 1657.

THOMAS 4 HAMMOND (Thomas 3, William 2, Thomas 1.) b. July 11, 1656, m. Elizabeth Noyes Aug. 21, 1678, who died Apr. 4, 1679. 2d m. Sarah Pickard Dec. 1679, another record says Dec. 6, 1680; had seven children; Hannah; Sarah; Thomas b. Nov. 17, 1685; Elizabeth; David bap. Nov. 23, 1690; Nathaniel, Jonathan both bap. July 25, 1697. Nathaniel b. as early as 1692, and continues the line.

NATHANIEL 5 HAMMOND (Thomas 4, Thomas 3, William 2, Thomas 1.) b. about 1692, m. Bridget. 2d m. Abigail —, of Chelmsford, Mass, who died Aug. 20, 1746, had seven children, but the order of them is doubtful, the record of Aaron Hammond, b. 1742, places them, Thomas, Jonathan and Joseph, first; although Jonathan came, with his father, to this town four years previous to the coming of Thomas, who came Nov. 4, 1741; Jonathan b. 1714, came Oct. 10, 1737; Joseph b. about 1722, came to this town 1744; Nathaniel Jr. came Nov. 4, 1741, and d. Oct. 14, 1743; Timothy b. Feb. 27, 1724. d. in this town Sept. 27, 1746; Sarah b. Apr. 13, 1727, m. Oliver Metcalf, of Keene; Oliver b. Oct. 29, 1729, came to
