


Account of Peter Temple.

1553, obtained from the Crown a grant of the manor of Merston Boteler, co. Warwick.



1554, leased the manor of Stowe¹ from the Bishop of Oxford.

1560, purchased two-thirds of the manor of Burton Dassett, co. Warwick.

1567, received a grant of the following arms: "Argent, a chevron sable charged with five martlets of the field, between three crescents gules."

JOHN TEMPLE,
OF STOWE.

Born: in 1542.

Died: at Stowe, May 11th 1603; buried at Burton Dassett.

Will: July 18th 1597; proved May 26th 1603. (32 Bolein.)³

Married: November 24th 1561, Susan, second daughter and coheirress of Thomas Spencer, of Everdon, co. Northampton; her will of December 16th 1612 was proved July 8th 1614; (89 Lane);⁴ buried with her husband.
