1. **John Temple**; over 21 in 1655; executor of the will of his grandmother, Mary, 2d wife of Sir Alexander Temple, Kt.
2. **Alexander Temple**, of whom later.
3. **James Temple**; alive in 1654.
4. **Peter Temple**; alive in 1654.

**Account of James Temple.**

A Colonel in the Parliamentary service; a signer of the death-warrant of Charles I.

**ALEXANDER TEMPLE,**

OF BALLINDERRY, IRELAND.

**Died:** in Ireland, November 28th; buried December 3d 1663.<sup>1</sup>

**Married:** Mary, daughter and heiress of Calcot Chambre, and granddaughter of Calcot Chambre, of Denbigh, Wales, and Carnowe, co. Wicklow, Esq.; as a widow, she married Henry Temple, of Lincoln's Inn, of the Line of Coughton.

**Issue.**

1. ——— **Temple**; he died prior to 1663.
2. **Mary Temple**; married in November 1676, Abraham Yarner, second son of Sir Abraham Yarner, of Dublin, Kt.

<sup>1</sup> Among the funeral entries in Ulster's office at Dublin Castle, we find in Vol. 14, p. 57: "Mr. Alexander Temple died 28th of November and buried the 3d of December, 1663. He married Mary, dau. of Calcot Chambre, by whom he had a son and a dang: now living named Mary. Arms: Argent, two bars sable, each charged with three martlets or; impaling azure, a dexter arm embowed in armour or, holding a rose gules slipt vert."
