(Third son of Sir Thomas Temple, 1st Bart.)

Married: —, daughter of — Green, D. D.**Died:** alive in 1654, though not in 1683.**Issue.**

1. **Thomas II Temple**, of whom later.
2. **John I Temple**; not of age in 1654; alive in 1683, at which time he had a son, John II Temple.
3. **Sandys Temple**; not of age in 1654; presumed to have been a captain in the Royal Navy; probably not alive in 1683.

1614, Captain.

1622-1649, Vicar of Burton-on-the-water, co. Gloucester; is presumed to have eventually settled in Ireland.

2. **Richard Temple**; alive in 1683.

Not of age in 1654. Mentioned in 1671 in the first will of Sir Thomas Temple, of Nova Scotia.
