III. PETRUS STUYVESANT, born Jan. 26, 1792, baptized in the Dutch church Feb. 5, 1792. "My father-in-law and mother-in-law were God-father and God-mother, my sister Betsey and my brother-in-law, Nicholas Wm. Stuyvesant, appeared in church in their stead, they not being then in Albany."

After graduating at Columbia College, this son studied theology with Rev. Nathaniel Bowen, D. D., was admitted by Bishop Hobart to Deacon's orders June 30, 1816, "in St. Ann's Church, in the village of Brooklyn, New York," and to Priest's orders April 2, 1817, "in St. Paul's Church in the town of East Chester, New York."

He was afterwards Rector of Trinity Church, Fishkill, and had also charge of St. Philip's Church, Philipstown and St. Peter's Church, Peekskill. From 1818 to 1831, Rector of St. Paul's Church, Portland, Maine, and from 1836 to 1844, of St. Paul's Church, Concord, N. H.

He married, August 10, 1819, Lucretia Loring, daughter of Levi Cutter and Lucretia Mitchell, of Portland,
