

THIRD GENERATION.

“Thomas Brackett killed by the Indians in Falmouth, Me., in 1676, was a son of Anthony Brackett, “Selectman” of Portsmouth, N. H. He had by his wife, Miss Mary Cleeves, (grand-daughter of George Cleeves,) five children, four of them were killed, or carried away by the Indians in 1676, the other one Joshua, born in Falmouth, in 1674, escaped and settled in Greenland, N. H. Thomas Brackett’s wife was carried away to Canada by the Indians, and died the first year of her captivity.”

Joshua Brackett, born in Falmouth, Me. in 1674.

HIS CHILDREN:

Joshua Jr. and Anthony went from Greenland, N. H., to Old Falmouth, Me., after the re-settlement of the town in about 1728, and claimed their inheritance (land).

Joshua Brackett Jr., born in Greenland, N. H., 1701; died in March, 1794.

Anthony Brackett, born in Greenland, N. H. in 1707; died Sept. 10, 1784; married first, Miss Sarah Knight, Feb. 14, 1733, married second, his 2d cousin, Mrs. Kerenhappuck Hicks, (widow) daughter of Sarah (Brackett) Proctor. She was born in 1729; died 1822.
