Thomas had ten children, one of whom, Eleanor, married James Robinson, and by this union we have Rachel Robinson, who married Thomas Hamilton. Eleanor Hamilton, of this marriage, was united to Joseph Hoopes. Joseph was the son of David Hoopes and Esther Townsend, and a brother of Susanna Hoopes, who married Isaac Wilson, whose daughter Alisanna married John Okely of Baltimore, born 1785.

Thus we find that the Okely descendants are collateral, but not lineal, descendants of Richard de Guylpyn. [See chart B.—ED.]
