

The household furniture, with the exception of his clock, writing desk and "Scea chest," was divided equally among the three daughters. The remainder of the estate was left to his son Henry Emes, who was named executor.

Jesse Emes married 1st, Bette Bent, daughter of John and Elizabeth (Reed) Bent, who was born May 1, 1743, and "died Feb. ye 14, 1776, being sick 8 days;" 2nd, April 7, 1777, Mrs. Dorothy (Child) Brown of East Sudbury, who died March 8, 1813, aged 71 years; 3rd, Jan. 28, 1819, Mrs. Fanny Parminter. At the time of this third marriage Jesse Emes was eighty years old and his bride seventy years. They lived happily together for ten years.
