WILLIAM, son of William, son of Samuel, son of Thomas 1st, born in Windsor, December 3, 1701. He married Mary, daughter of Deacon Cornelius and Abigail (Loomis) Brown, and had: 1, William, in 1727; 2, Abigail, 1730; 3, Elijah, 1731; 4, Abigail, 1733; 5, Luther, 1736. He resided for a time in Poquonnock Parish.

JOSEPH, son of Joseph, son of Samuel, son of Thomas, born at Windsor, January 28, 1709. Married Elizabeth, daughter of Nathaniel Cook, and had: 1, Joseph, in 1729; 2, Elizabeth, 1731; 3, Lucy, 1733, married Richard Brittain; 4, Asenah, 1736; 5, Savannah, 1738; 6, Elisha, in 1740.

DANIEL, son of Joseph, son of Samuel, son of Thomas 1st, born April 23, 1719. Married Naomi, daughter of John Barber, and had: 1, Naomi, in 1743; 2, Daniel, born in 1744. Both Daniel, Sr., and Jr., served in the Continental Army, the father commanding a company at its close. The son is known as the Rev. Daniel Barber, author of a work entitled "My Own Times," published in Washington in 1827.
