

b. *Mary Anne*, of 29, Green Street, Grosvenor Square, London, spinster, baptized at Welshpool, 12 March, 1797.

III. *John Evans*, of the Farm, in Tirymynech, yeoman, was born about 1734, as he was aged 83 at the time of his death on the 19 May, 1817. He was buried at Pool. He was twice married:—1, to *Mary Minton*, and 2, to *Mary*, daughter to *John Jones*, of Varchwell, sister to his brother *Thomas Evans's* second wife. His will is dated 8 Feb., 1792, describing him as of Pool Quay, co. Montg. He leaves 5*l.* each to his son *Thomas* and his daughter *Ann*, the wife of *Thomas Williams*, and his residuary estate to his wife *Mary*, during her widowhood, with remainder to his children by her. He appointed his nephew *Thomas Evans*, of Welshpool, his executor, who renounced, and thereupon administration, *cum test. annexo*, was granted to the widow, who survived until 21 May, 1831, when she died, aged 89.

By his 1st wife, *Mary Minton*, he had issue:—

1. *Thomas Evans*, who, by his first wife, *Margaret Griffiths*, had issue:—
 - a. *Elizabeth*, dead in 1853.
 - b. *Margaret*, wife of *Charles Shaw* of Mollington, alive in 1853; since dead.
 - c. *Joyce*, bap. at Pool, 14 January, 1788, dead in 1853.

and by his second wife, *Mary Meredith*, had two children living in 1853, viz.:—

 - d. *Mary*, wife of *William Wainwright*.
 - e. *Ann*, wife of *Thomas Henry Mitchell*, captain in H. M.'s army unattached, and Governor of *Salford* goal.
2. *Anne*, who married twice:—1. On 29 Sept., 1798, *Edward Griffiths* (buried at *Guildsfield*, 8 Jan., 1792), by whom she had two children; viz.:—
 - a. *Edward Griffiths* of *Newcastle-upon-Tyne*, gent. (born in 1779, and died 21 December, 1863), who had issue *Edward Griffiths* of the same place, solicitor, living 1865, unmarried, and two daughters.
 - b. *Thomas Griffiths*, died in his infancy, and buried 14 May, 1781.

And 2. on 15 November, 1783, at *Guildsfield*, *Thomas Williams* of *Carreghova* (who died 22 May, 1798, aged 36, and was buried at *Llanymynech*), by whom she had issue:—

- a. *Thomas Williams*, died 28 Sep., 1802, aged 18.
