- b. *Alfred Edward Hill*, born at Worcester, 13 May, died 26 Aug., 1847, at Lowestoff.
- c. *Edward Henry Hill*, born 10 Feb., 1849, in par. St. Martin's, Worcester, bap. at Congregational Chapel.
- d. *Mary Evans*, born 4 Jan., 1851, in same parish.
- e. *Catherine Eliza*, born there 19 Apr., 1852, bap. at Catherine Hill House, by Rev. Dr. Redford.

- 4. *Eliza Bickerton*, born at Worcester, 17 Dec., 1815, registered at Dr. Williams' Library.
- 5. *Hannah Myra*, born April 3, 1818, at Worcester, who died March 14, 1821, and was buried in burial ground of Angel Street Chapel, Worcester, (birth unregistered).
- 6. *Sarah Sugden*, born at Worcester, 3 Feb., 1817, registered at Dr. Williams' Library, Red Cross Street, was married at the Congregational Chapel, Worcester, 26 July, 1842, to David Everett, surgeon, Worcester, eldest son of Isaac Everett, of Wix Lodge, Essex, by whom she has had issue:—
 - a. *Isaac Edward Everett*, born at Worcester, 13 April, 1844, articulated to the law.

IV. *Elizabeth*, born 9 Jan. 1785 (who, advanced now to her 81st year, remembers distinctly her great grandfather John Jones, of Trewern, who died at the age of 92 and would be born in the reign of William III.), was married in 1806 to Morris Jones, formerly of Welshpool, afterwards of Gungrog, Montgomeryshire, esq., who died 10 Dec., 1843, whilst Mayor of Welshpool, buried in Pool Church Yard. He was only surviving child of Morris Jones, of Eardiston, Salop, who died 1815 (by Elizabeth his wife, formerly Fardoe). This last Morris Jones was second son of David Jones, of Buyton, Salop, who was eldest son of William Jones, of Welshpool, a burgess of
