

V. *Anna*, born at 62, Wood Street, City of London, 6 Dec., 1823, bap. at St. Botolph's, 3 May, 1842, died at Versailles, 17 Oct., 1850, buried in the Cemetery, Notre Dame, Versailles. She was married, 27 Nov., 1844, at St. Bartholomew's, Smithfield, to Edward Webb, an artist, fourth son of Charles Webb of Piccadilly, by his wife Ann Aston. They had issue:—

THOMAS BICKERTON EVANS, of Liverpool, and of Greenside House, Wavertree, born in the Foregate, Worcester, 29 May, 1810, bap. in London. He married, 25 April, 1843, at Clarendon Place, Glasgow, Agnes, eldest daughter and eventual coheirress of Peter Fleming of Wallace Grove, Glasgow, by Janet, sister of the Rev. Dr. Wallace, of the Old Church, Dumfries. She was born at Glasgow, 12 Nov., 1819, was bap. at Glasgow Tron Church, and died at Wavertree, 9 October, 1863, and was buried at Smithdown Lane Cemetery.
