George von Bauer,⁹ b. Dec. 28, 1846; m. Feb. 9, 1875, Amelia Kutzleb; he was a soldier of the rebellion; was a bridge-carpenter; his family resides in Columbus, Ind. He d. Oct. 28, 1883. They had: Edith Louise,¹⁰ b. Dec. 9, 1875, and Frank Ernest,¹⁰ b. Sept. 6, 1878.

Henry,⁹ b. May 20, 1849; d. Mar. 21, 1851.

Margaret Will,⁹ b. Dec. 26, 1852; she has never married. Miss Mosbaugh is rather a remarkable woman, well educated, refined, with some literary talent, a very amiable disposition, and much devoted to her kindred, all of which secures to her hosts of friends. She was born in Cambridge City, lived there until she was about thirteen years old, when she went to live with her sister Henrietta, at Cincinnati, where she went to school; she graduated from Woodward High School in 1872. She taught in Cambridge City, and Mishawaka, Ind., and Newport, Ky. She now teaches mathematics in Woodward High School, where she has been for eight or nine years. She is a member of the Methodist church.
