



Robert Russe of Croscombe, clothier. Will dated 19 April 1651 proved in (late) P.C.C. 21 Nov. 1651.



Hester Bisse. Mar. before 30 Jan. 1608. Living 19 April 1651.

Robert Bisse of Shepton Mallett, co. Somerset, clothier. Will dated 8 Oct. 1641; proved in P.C.C. 26 Jan. 1643-4.

Hester . . . Living Hilary Term 24 Charles I.

James Bisse of . . . Westcombe (probably in parish Batcombe). Living 8 Oct. 1641.

Philip Bisse of Christchurch, London, citizen and vintner of London. Apprenticed 3 Dec. 1639, and admitted to the freedom of his Company 1 Dec. 1646. Adm'on 31 Jan. 1653-4. Probably son of this James.

Ursula . . . Living 31 Jan. 1653-4.

John Bisse of St. Bartholomew's by the Exchange, London. Adm'on in the (late) P.C.C. 15 Oct. 1651 to his brother Philip.
