

James Bisse of West Compton, gent. Mar. settlement dated 7 Feb. 1710. Died 15 Jan. 1714, aged 29, leaving a will. M.I. in Pilton Chancel.

Elizabeth, one of the two dau'ts of Richard Combs of Stalbridge, co. Dorset, gent. (who died about 1690), by Mary his wife. Mar. soon after she attained 21. Living 30 June 1722.

John Bisse, 2nd son. Admitted at Balliol College, Oxford, 9 May 1715; B.A. 6 Feb. 1718; M.A. 13 Nov. 1721. Lived sometime at West Compton. Instituted to the Rectory of Weston-super-Mare, co. Somerset, 16 Dec. 1723, to which living Thomas Sparry was instituted on his death 13 July 1747.

Margaret Towgood of Axbridge, co. Somerset, sister of John Towgood, Esq., of Bristol. Mar. 1727.

Robert Bisse of West Compton, clothier. Will dated 16 Sept. 1721; proved in P.C.C. 27 Jan. 1725-6.

James Bisse. Died an infant. M.I. in Pilton Chancel.

Anne Bisse. Mar. Lancelot Cooper of Bristol, merchant, and had issue. See Burke's 'Landed Gentry,' 1853.

John Connell, afterwards O'Connell, Esq., sometime of Bristol, afterwards of London, and latterly of Brussels, son of Michael Connell, M.D., by Philippa, da. of James, 6th Earl of Abercorn, and widow of Rev. Benjamin Pratt, D.D. Died at Brussels 1808.

Katherine Bisse. Born about 1740. Mar. 1758. Died at Brussels 1798.

1st wife, Margaret Bisse. Under 21 on 3 March 1704. Mar. before 8 May 1718. Living 16 Sept. 1721. M.I. in Pilton Chancel.

Elias Rebotier. Born at St. John de Gardonnenque in the Cevennes in the province of Languedoc, France. Instituted to the Prebend of Dinder in Wells Cathedral 3 Dec. 1712; to the Prebend of Henstridge in the same 26 April 1718; and to the Prebend of Wiveliscombe in the same 23 Jan. 1719-20; also to the Rectory of Axbridge, co. Somerset, on the last mentioned day. He resigned the Prebend of Dinder in 1718. Died 19 Dec. 1765, aged 88. M.I. in Axbridge Church. Will dated 25 Nov. 1765; proved in P.C.C. 21 Jan. 1766, and DE BO. NON 24 July 1765.

2nd wife, Elizabeth Chorley, spinster. Died 20 Feb. 1766, aged 74. M.I. in Axbridge Church. Will dated 29 Aug. 1759; adm'on with same in P.C.C. 28 June 1766.

Thomas George of Croscombe, gent. Died 31 May 1741, aged 71. M.I. in Croscombe Chancel. Will, in which he describes himself as a clothier, dated 29 April 1735; proved in P.C.C. 23 June 1741.

Katherine Bisse. Under 16 mar. 16 Sept. 1721. Died 27 Jan. 1743, aged 59. M.I. in Croscombe Chancel.

Amy Bisse. Living 28 June 1689, but not mentioned in her father's will.

Ann Bisse. Under 21 on 3 March 1704. Living unmar. 16 Sept. 1721.

Edith Bisse. Under 21 on 3 March 1704. Living unmar. 16 Sept. 1721.
