Samuel Bisse of Hill Bishop, co. Somerset, in 1623, afterwards of Wells. Matriculated at Oxford from Magdalen College 21 June 1583, then aged 16; B.A. 11 Feb. 1590-1; M.A. 4 July 1594. Adm'on in P.C.C. 28 July 1636 to son George.

Prudence, da. of George Prouse of Kingston next Yeovil, co. Somerset, gent. (whose will, dated 10 Aug. 1623, was proved with a codicil, dated 3 Nov. 1624, in P.C.C. 17 Feb. 1624-5), by Thomasin, da. of James Goddard of Wellington. Died before 28 July 1636.

Thomas Bisse, M.A., Fellow of All Souls' College, Oxford. Ordained Deacon by Bishop of London 24 Feb. 1604-5 (then aged 29 or thereabouts), and priest by the same 26 May 1606. Instituted to the Rectory of Weston-super-Mare, co. Somerset, 1612. Admitted to a Prebend in Bristol Cathedral (second stall) 19 Feb. 1612-13. Instituted to Rectory of Elingdon alias Wroughton, co. Wilts, 28 May 1622, and instituted to Vicarage of Were, co. Somerset, 9 March 1626-7. Died 1632. Will dated 20 Aug. 1632; proved in P.C.C. 15 Feb. 1632-3.

Elizabeth, da. of Richard Garborne of co. Oxford. Mar. before 17 Jan. 1610. Living 16 Feb. 1632-3.

Philip Bisse of Magdalen College, Oxford, Bachelor of Laws. Born 5 May 1611. Described as of Cheddar, co. Somerset, gent., 11 Nov. 1634. Instituted to the Vicarage of Poundstock, co. Cornwall, 27 April 1637, his successor in which living was instituted 7 Feb. 1639-40. Archdeacon of Cloyne 13 Aug. 1641, and murdered by the Irish rebels in the autumn of 1642. Died intestate.

Bridget, da. of George Barber of Ashmore, co. Dorset, gent. (whose will, dated 7 June 1661, was proved in P.C.C. 13 June 1662), by Lucy his wife (whose will, dated 14 Dec. 1672, was also proved in P.C.C. 13 March 1673-4). Mar. about 1638. Died in Ireland about 1642.

Philip Bisse of Salisbury, co. Wilts, clothier, 27 Nov. 1662, afterwards of Bellchalwell, co. Dorset, gent., only child. Born about 1639. Living 25 Jan. 1679.

... da. of John Straight, M.A., of Queen's College, Cambridge; Chaplain to the Bishop of Salisbury, and Vicar of Stour Paine and Turnworth, co. Dorset (whose will, dated 25 Jan. 1679, was proved in P.C.C. 14 July 1680 and 12 Oct. 1680). Mar. before 7 July 1674. Living 25 Jan. 1679.

* Eleanor . . . Died 31 Aug. 1642, set. 29. M.I. in Oldbury Chancel.

Thomas Bisse, M.A. Was at Brasenose College, Oxford, 20 Aug. 1632. Instituted to Rectory of Oldbury-on-the-Hill, co. Glouc., 4 Nov. 1641, and bur. in that parish 20 Sept. 1656. Will dated 16 Sept. 1656; proved in London 2 Feb. 1656-7.
