

us to trace the name onward through the close of the fourteenth and beginning of the fifteenth centuries.

From these we learn that John ap Rees, a descendant of Eliston Glodred, founder of the fourth Royal tribe of Wales, had three sons, *Roger Cambray*, *William* or *Watkin Cambray* who married Cecily, and *Jenkyn Cambray* who married Dorothy, daughters and co-heirs of Sir Walter Collins, of Stretton, and who appear to have been paternally descended from Eliston Glodred, their mother having been a Cambray, it not being an uncommon thing for sons thus to assume their mother's name. The daughter of Watkin Cambray married a John Leighton. Burke gives the date of this marriage as 1383, which helps us to fix the others.

In addition to the above, we gather that a John Moore married Margery, daughter and heir to a Richard Cambraye, one generation removed from the sons of John ap Rees, while a John Trevor, who died 1497, married Ann or Agnes, daughter and heir to Piers Cambre, of Poole. Finally the arms of Wolrich, of Dudmaston, are given quarterly of twenty, the twentieth quarter being, Argent, three boar's heads coupéd close, sable—Cambray. These were the arms of Cadwgan, son of Eliston Glodred. Vincent, in his Ordinary, gives "Camery, Or a bend between three boar's heads sable," whilst we find the arms of Piers Cambre, of Poole, *i.e.*, Welshpool, are given as "Argent a wyvern volant sable," being the same as those attributed to Roger de Cambria two centuries before.

Continuing our investigation into the fifteenth century we gather from the "Inquisitiones post mortem" taken upon the death of the various tenants in chief that in 1399 the heirs of a *John Cameray* held the fourth part of a knight's fee at Mid Rydware, in Staffordshire from William, brother and heir of Thomas, Earl of Stafford, while in 1460 a *John Cameray* held the same land from Humphry, Duke of Buckingham. A *John Cambray*, living in 1432, also held land in knight's
