Robert Cambray, of Great Rissington, yeoman ; "a fourth of that name born in Oct. 1689" ; bap. at Great Rissington, p. r. ; d. there 12 May 1772, aged 84, m. i. ; bur. there 14 May 1772, p.r. ; will dated 20 Apr. 1772, proved in Gloucester ; by his wife *Hannah*, who died 6 Mar. 1746, aged 61, m.i., and was bur. at Great Rissington, he had issue—

- i. *Sarah*, bap. at Great Rissington, 12 Aug. 1715, p. r., mar. *Giles Cripps*, of Hatherop.
- ii. *Robert Cambray*, "the fifth of the name," bap. at Great Rissington, 16 Apr. 1718, p. r. ; died there, 5 Nov., and was bur. 7 Nov. 1757, p. r. ; will dated 9 Oct. 1757, proved in Gloucester ; mar., 1st, *Elizabeth*, dau. of Richard *Harbidge*, of Chaselton, at Hampnett, 1743 (she died 17 Sept. 1746, aged 24, m. i.) ; 2ndly, *Elizabeth*, whose will was proved in Gloucester, 6 June 1764. He left no issue.
