- Richard [? Robart] Camery Filius Ricardi sepultus est 8 Die Julii 1549.

 Gorge Camery sepultus est 6 Die Aprilis 1552.
 Johanna Camery sepulta fuit eodem die (15 April 1552).
 Robartus Camery primo die Martii sepultus est 1553-4.
 Wilm Camery sepultus est 1 Die Novembris 1556.
 Elizabeth Camery sepulta fuit (7 ?) Die Novembris 1561.

- 1564.—November 27, borne the same 27 day Alice, the daughter of Richard Camberye; godfather and godmothers, Richard Willat, Alice Smyth, and Agnes Altaffe.
 1568.—October 10, christened, Richard Camberye, the son of Richard of Shipton.
 1572.—April 7, christened, Joane Cambrey, the daughter of Richard Cambrey of Shipton.
 1572.—June 4, buried, Joane Cambrye, the daughter of Richard Cambrye of Shipton.
 1574.—Sep. 12, christened, Lyngborough Cambrye, the daughter of Richard Cambrye of Shipton.
 1580.—September 29, christened, Thomas Cambrye, the son of Richard Cambrye of Shipton.
 1585.—November 27, buried, Richard Cambrey, an elderlye man of 80 years of age and of Shipton.
