

*Marie Cambrye*, of Little Rissington. Dated 10 Feb. 1603. To be buried at Little Rissington. My brother Richard Cambrie and his wife between them £10. Thomas, son of Richard Cambrie, £10. Edward, Jane, & Mary, children of said Richard, 20s. a piece. Sister Margaret 30s. Brother William 30s. Uncle Peter Cambrie and his wife 10s. Richard Cambry, son of Thomas Cambry, 12s., Cousin Margaret Cambry, 20s. Cousin William Cambry, my "diaper table cloth." Cousin Joane [?] and Sister Alice, personal chattels. Poor of Little Rissington 10s., Broad Rissington 10s., Fifield 10s., Burton-on-the-Water 10s. Richard Cambery, son of Peter Cambery, 10s. Residue to Uncle Thomas, executor. William Davis and Richard Cambery, overseers. Witnesses: Henry Gyllet, clerck, Richard Cambery, and others. Proved in Gloucester.

*Robert Cambray*, of Broad Rissington, yeoman. Dated 27 Dec. 1662. Daughters Margaret, Joyce, Elizabeth, £200 each at 24. Son William, £20. Grandson William £10. Son William's Daus. Mary and Ann, £5 each at 21. Grandson John Aurchard, £10. Grandchildren Elizabeth, Anthony, Mary, Margaret Aurchard, £5 each at 21. Dau. Alice, wife of Anthony Aurchard, 5s. His wife to hold the half of his lands and tenements and his son Robert the other half. On their deaths to his son Robert's son Robert and his heirs. Wife and sons Robert and William, executors. Proved (P.C.C. 63 Juxon) 27 May 1663.

*Robert Cambray*, of Broad Rissington, yeoman. Dated 12 Aug. 1684. Wife Elinor all his household goods and the life interest in a house and lands in Rissington with remainder to his son William. Residue to son Robert, executor. Proved in Gloucester, 25 May 1685.

*Thomas Cambray*, of Broad Rissington. Dated 20 May 1693. Brother George, "living in Ireland, if he come to demand it," £10. Widow of brother John, £5. Eldest sister's granddaughter at Wantage, £5. Poor of parish, £5. "My Landlady, in lieu of her heriot or heriots if she be so pleased," £5. Cousin Richard Cambray, the elder, and his son-in-law Robert Cambray, executors, the residue and the "Deades Grant of my copyhold estate in Broad Rissington." Witnesses: William Cambray, Thomas Cambray, William Renfield. Proved (P.C.C., 27 Box) 10 Feb. 1694.

NOTE.—It is uncertain whose son this Thomas Cambray was. A family of the name of Camby, or Cambie, have existed in Ireland from 1668 to the present day.
