Robert Pickering of Crowley Lodge, in the parish of Northwood, co. Chester, afterwards of Thelwall Hall, co. Chester. Barrister and Reader at Gray's Inn. Aged 45 at the Herald's Visitation of Chester a° 1664. Lord of the Manor of Thelwall by purchase 4 Dec. 1661. Bapt. 30 Nov. 1619 at Daresbury, co. Chester.

Martha, dau. of the Rev. John Lay, M.A., one of the Prebends of the Cathedral Church of Chester, Sub-Dean of Chester, Vicar of Great Budworth, co. Chester, and Rector of Solihull and Sutton Coldfield, co. Warwick.

John Pickering of Gray's Inn, Barrister-at-Law. Afterwards of Thelwall Hall, and Lord of the Manor of Thelwall aforesaid, eldest son and heir, set. 19 at the Herald's Visitation of Chester a° 1664.

Abigail, eldest dau. of the Hon. Philip Sherard of Whissendine, co. Rutland, M.P., bapt. 17 Feb. 1652 at Stapelford (by *Margaret, dau. of Sir Thomas Denton of Hillesdon, co. Bucks, and widow of the Hon. William Bure, son of William, Lord Bure, and second son of William, Lord Sherard, Baron of Leictrian, by Abigail, elder dau. and coheirress of Cecil Cave, Esq., of Stamford, co. Northampton.*)

Robert Pickering of St. John's College, Cambridge, 2nd son, M.A., Rector of Eccleston and Croston, co. Pal. Lanc. Died before 1712, s.p.

Mary, dau. of Hugh Curre of Kildwick Hall, co. York. Marriage settlement dated 1 and 2 May 1677.

Other issue.

John Pickering of Thelwall Hall aforesaid, Lord of the Manors of Thelwall and Hatton, co. Chester. In the Commission of the Peace for the said county. Died 26 Dec. 1747, set. 73. Buried at Thelwall. Will dated 6 Jan. 1730. Proved at Chester.

Charlotte, 4th dau. of Sir Willoughby Aston of Aston, co. Chester, Bart. Born 22 Sept. 1679. Marriage settlement dated 20 and 21 Feb. 1695. Married 23 Feb. 1695. Died 29 March, and buried 2 April 1751, set. 71, at Thelwall. Will dated 16 May 1749. Proved at Chester.

Sherard Pickering of Clifford's Inn, London. Bapt. 11 Oct. 1680 at Whissendine aforesaid. Will dated 12 Nov. 1715, codicil 6 Aug. 1717. Proved 3 March 1719-20.

Alexander Pickering. Married dau. of Thomas Woolley.

Other issue.

Elizabeth, widow of Thomas Pickering of Thelwall Hall aforesaid. Lord of the Manor of . . . Lacy of Gadlis, co. Flint. Married before July 1748.

Thomas Pickering of Thelwall Hall aforesaid. Lord of the Manor of . . . Shore of Ealing, co. Middlesex. Marriage settlement dated 11 May 1775.

Willoughby Richard Pickering of Hanover Square, co. Middlesex, Doctor of Medicine, 2nd son. Died intestate. Admon. granted to his brother Thomas.

Elizabeth, dau. of . . . Shore, by Hannah his wife. Died 21 May 1776, set. 50.

Henry Pickering of the City of Westminster, 3rd son. Died before 1756.

Elizabeth. Died before 1775.

Charlotte. Living unmarried 1775.

George Keen of Stafford, only child and heir, sometime Alderman and Mayor of the Borough of Stafford. Died 18 Dec. 1822, set. 85. Buried at Handsworth aforesaid.

Elizabeth Mary, only dau. and heir, and also heiress-at-law of her uncle Thomas Pickering. Born 1 and bapt. 23 June 1748 at St. George's, Hanover Square, co. Middlesex. Died 21 Feb. 1803. Buried at Handsworth. s.p.

Willoughby Richard John Pickering, only son. Born 20 June and bapt. 16 July 1747. Died 19 Jan. 1754, aged 6 years and 7 months.
