

## **Lubbock of Norwich.**

Arms granted, 8 June 1730, to THOMAS LUBBOCK, son of Richard Lubbock, by Elizabeth his wife, eldest daughter and one of the coheirs of Thomas Palgrave, all of the City of Norwich, and the Heirs and other Descendants of Richard Lubbock aforesaid :

Argent, a mount and thereon a stork proper, on a chief gules three estoiles of the first. And for the Crest : On a wreath of the colours a stork rising proper, reposing the dexter foot on an antique shield charged with the arms of Palgrave, being Azure, a lion rampant-guardant argent.
