

Bapt. 3 February 1567-8; mar. at North Walsham 26 September 1591 Margery Carryour, who survived him; mentioned with his wife in will of his father; his will, dated 16 December 1605, proved 13 January 1605-6, mentions the freeholds in North Walsham which he inherited from his father Nicholas, lands in Cocklegate, Massegate, Eastgate, Churchgate, and Hegge, all in North Walsham parish. He was buried at North Walsham 23 December 1605, having had six sons and three daughters :—

- (1) Nicholas, bapt. 9 August 1592; bur. at North Walsham 24 August 1592.
- (2) Edmund, bapt. 27 May 1595; buried at North Walsham 20 June 1595.
- (3) Henry, bapt. 3 June 1596 (of whom see below, p. 20).
- (4) Robert, bapt. 4 June 1598; mentioned in his father's will as to inherit the land at Cocklegate; bur. at North Walsham 4 July 1617.
- (5) William, bapt. 13 June 1599; mentioned in his father's will as to inherit the property in Massegate and Eastgate, North Walsham; mentioned with his wife Ema in various entries in the North Walsham Manor Rolls, A.D. 1628—1639. He was buried at
