

ham, worsted weaver, bapt. 8 June 1621; mentioned in his father's will as eldest son, and as being already provided for; was executor to his son Samuel's will 1687; appointed Registrar of North Walsham 24 September 1653; was admitted to the manor of North Walsham 10 October 1642, and to Antingham Manor 17 October 1662; married at North Walsham 27 September 1644 Dorothy Nilgress; she was buried at North Walsham 9 May 1704. His will, dated 24 September 1693, proved 28 June 1694, mentions his silver cups and other plate. He "died 14 June 1694, aged 73," and was buried 16 June 1694, at North Walsham, where is a monumental inscription to him on the outside wall of the church, under the east window, having had issue five sons :—

(1) Samuel, bapt. 27 July 1645 (of whom see below, p. 23).

(2) Joseph, bapt. 18 April 1647; mentioned in wills of his father and brother Samuel; mar. at North Walsham 7 June 1672 Ann Alexander; he was buried at North Walsham 22 February 1687-8; administration granted to his widow Ann 27 April 1688; having had issue three sons and one daughter :—
