

RICHARD LUBBOCK (son of Nicholas and Anne, *vide supra*, p. 47), of Coltishall; mentioned in will of his father, from whom he inherited the houses and lands in Coltishall, Sco-Ruston, and Scottow; was a party to a suit as to tithes at Coltishall 1654, *Exch. B. and A., Commonwealth, Norf.*, No. 28; married at the Cathedral, Norwich, 20 June 1643, Etheldreda (*vel* Audrey) Whitwell, who was buried at Coltishall 10 July 1685. His will, dated 10 May, proved 1 July 1668, mentions several different "places" and houses in Coltishall and the vicinity belonging to him. He was buried at Coltishall 17 June 1668, having had issue four sons and four daughters:—

- (1) John Lubbock, of Coltishall, yeoman, bapt. 28 July 1645; mentioned as eldest son in his father's will, from whom he inherited the bulk of the Coltishall estates; his wife Mary was buried 7 June 1676. His will was dated 4 August 1681; he died s.p., and was buried at Coltishall 27 December 1681.
- (2) Nicholas Lubbock, of Coltishall, bapt. 16 February 1646-7; mentioned in wills of his father and brother John; from the latter he inherited his property at Coltishall; he married Hannah, daughter of . . . and Mary Brown, of Scottow; he was buried at Coltishall 26 February 1681-2, leaving issue one
