

- (3) Etheldreda, bapt. 13 February 1658-9; mentioned in her father's will, and as unmarried in that of her brother John.
- (4) Amy, bapt. 16 December 1664; mentioned in her father's will, and in that of her brother John as unmarried.

RICHARD LUBBOCK (son of Nicholas and Hannah, *vide supra*, p. 50), of Norwich, bapt. at Coltishall 4 December 1676; a brewer; Sheriff of Norwich 1714, Alderman 1715, Mayor 1717; married Elizabeth, eldest daughter and coheir of Thomas Palgrave, Esq., of Norwich and Pulham Market, co. Norfolk (he was Sheriff of Norwich 1699, and M.P. for Norwich 1703, 1704, and 1707). She married, 2nd, Richard Bacon, and died 6 June 1725, æt. 43; buried at St. George's, Colegate, Norwich (monumental inscription). Richard Lubbock died while Mayor 26 July 1717, and was buried at St. George's, Colegate, Norwich, in which church is a monumental tablet to his memory and that of his wife and infant children. Administration granted to his widow 12 August 1717. He had issue four sons and five daughters:—

- (1) Thomas Lubbock, of Norwich; admitted to Gonville and Caius College, Cambridge; "aged 17, 1720, born at Norwich;" B.A. 1723; to whom and the descendants of his father arms were granted 1730;
