

FIRST GENERATION.

Children of the Immigrant **Stephen Pierson** and **Mary Tomlinson**, all born in Derby, Conn.:

- 1.—*Sarah Pierson*, m. John Twitchell, Jan. 21, 1679.
- 2.—*Stephen Pierson, junior* (eldest son), m. Mehetabel Canfield, daughter of Thomas Canfield, Oct. 12, 1697.
- 3.—*Mary Pierson*, m. Josiah Baldwin Sept. 19, 1700.
- 4.—*John Pierson* (probably a bachelor), d. about 1704.
- 5.—*Bathsheba Pierson*, m. Adam Blackman of Stratford, Conn.
- 6.—*Abraham Pierson* (called Sergeant), b. in 1681; m. Sarah
—— (cannot learn her full name).
- 7.—*Daniel Pierson*, who drew lots in Oxford in 1713, was probably their son, but could find no proof of that fact.

SECOND GENERATION.

Children of 2 **Stephen Pierson, junior**, and **Mehetabel Canfield**, who was b. in Milford July 2, 1671:

- 8.—*Elizabeth Pierson*, b. Jan. 12, 1699, in Derby; m. a Mr. Bennett.
- 9.—*Thomas Pierson*, b. in Derby; m. first Ruth Holbrook of Derby Feb. 22, 1727-8, in Norwalk; second widow Elizabeth Thomas of Norwalk March 7, 1738.
- 10.—*John Pierson*, b. in Derby in 1705; m. —— Scrivener, daughter of Benjamin Scrivener of Norwalk; resided for a time in Norwalk, but d. in Huntington Jan. 25, 1789, aged 84. He had a son, William (whose wife was Hannah), and probably other children.
- 11.—*Job Pierson*, b. in Derby Oct. 5, 1707; d. in Derby in 1746-7, leaving a widow, Sarah, and sons, Stephen and Samuel.
- 12.—*Phebe Pierson*, b. in Derby; m. William Fanton.
- 13.—*Abigail Pierson*, b. in Derby; m. Mr. St. John.
- 14.—*Jonathan Pierson*, b. in Derby May 6, 1716; m. Mar. 5, 1739, Mary Bates.

Stephen Pierson, junior, died in Derby in 1744 intestate. Date of his wife's death has not been ascertained. His inventory list in 1717 was £51.
