

typhoid fever. Was borne away for dead at night. At daylight was to have been buried. A Mr. Strawn came to see the sick, saw signs of life, took him home, and nursed him until well. Served three years without a furlough; corporal.

August 25, 1864, married Louisa, daughter of Jabez Love of Harlem, Ills., and settled on the paternal homestead of 200 acres at Roscoe, Ills. After twenty-eight years rented farm to son-in-law and moved to Roscoe. Both are Methodists; he is a Republican. Has been collector, township supervisor seventeen years, present chairman supervisors Winnebago County, member F. & A. M., American Woodmen, Court of Honor, Knights of the Globe, Home Forum, president Rockford Creamery Company, Master of Masonic lodge, official of Methodist Episcopal Church, etc.

Mrs. Rhodes has been teacher of Bible class nine years, superintendent Sunday School two years, superintendent county Sunday School three years, president W. C. T. U. three years, W. C. Templar five terms, twice District V. Templar, several years W. Matron Eastern Star, clerk school board six years, clerk Roscoe cemetery ten years.
