EDWARD SHEPARD,¹ mariner, bought three parcels of land, 1639, at Cambridge, Mass. Stewards' records of Harvard College mention two importations of wheat, 1634, by Edward Shepard's vessel. His dwelling N. side South St., between Holyoke and Dunster.

JOHN SHEPARD,³ born 1653, Deacon South Church, Hartford, Conn.

JOHN SHEPARD,⁴ born October 26, 1681, Milford, Conn.

JOHN SHEPARD,⁵ born Milford, 1708, Ensign 1753, moved to Newton, Conn., 1737.

SIMEON SHEPARD,⁶ born 1739, died 1820, Newtown, Conn. Miller. He married Mary Hull.

DANIEL, born September 8, 1763, baptised May 27, 1764. Residence, Newtown, Conn.

ABEL, born September 5, 1765, baptised February, 11, 1766. Residence, Brutus, N. Y.

BETTY, born May 17, 1767, baptised July 26, 1767, married Terrill. Residence, Pavilion, N. Y.

SIMEON, born 1769, died 1800, married Duncombe. Residence, Connecticut.

JOHN, born 1771, married Eunice Lake, married second Nancy Leonard, died 1845? cancer. Residence, Shepard's Settlement.

JOSEPH, born 1775, married Polly Watkins. Settled in Shepard's Settlement, 1798; died, Red Creek, N. Y., 1845?

ANDREW, born 1773, 1791 married Charity Shelton, Newtown, Conn. Settled Marcellus, 1803. He died 1830; she, 1853.

MOLLY, born 1779, married Joseph North, Marcellus.

JERUSHA, born 1779, died 1797.

ELIPHALET HULL, born 1781, married Catharine Duncombe. Residence, Shepard's Settlement. He died 1847.

ISAAC, born 1786, married Polly Sears. Residence, Pavilion, N. Y.
