Fletcher Family Union.

(Instituted in Lowell, Mass., Aug. 30th, 1878.)

Articles of Association.

1. This Association shall be called the FLETCHER FAMILY UNION.
2. The officers of this society shall be a President, a Secretary, a Treasurer; also, in each State, a Vice-President, an Assistant Secretary, and an Assistant Treasurer, and also an Executive Committee of three persons, beside the President and Secretary, who shall be ex-officio members of said committee. All the said officers shall hold their offices until others shall have been chosen in their places, which choice shall be made each general meeting.
3. The Secretary shall keep a record of the proceedings of the society and of the executive committee, and shall be the custodian of the books, records, and papers of of the society.
4. The Vice-Presidents, Assistant Secretaries and Assistant Treasurers shall constitute State Boards to call local meetings in their respective States, and to promote generally the objects and interests of the Family Union, and make report through the Secretary of the Union.
5. The Executive Committee shall have a general charge and control of the affairs of the Union, including all financial matters, with the sole right to draw upon the Treasurer. They shall fill any vacancy in any office, including their own committee. They shall call a general Re-Union Meeting as often as once in five years from August 30, 1878.
