HENRY BAKER<sup>1</sup> came early to Pennsylvania. After returning to England for a time, he came to reside permanently, in 1684. He was foreman of the first Grand Jury of Bucks County, Overseer of Highways, Justice of the Peace in 1689, and Member of the Assembly in 1685, 1687, 1688, 1690 and 1698.

Sarah Baker, daughter of Henry Baker, married, in Middletown Monthly Meeting, 13 of 8 mc., 1692, Stephen Wilson.

Rebecca, the sixth child of Stephen and Sarah Baker Wilson, was born 20 of 6 mo., 1701, and married in Middletown Meeting, 8 of 2 mo., 1723, William Smith, (II).

Rachel, daughter of William and Rebecca Wilson Smith, born 3 of 5 mo., 1737, married, first, Henry Carver, secondly, Samuel Harrold. Her daughter Rebecca married Joseph Gillingham, as above.

Their children were: Rebecca H., born in Wilmington, 21 of 3 mo., 1834, George, born in Philadelphia, 21 of 12 mo., 1838. Rebecca married, 24 of 1 mo., 1856, Fairman Rogers, son of Evans and Caroline Rogers.
