1638-1897

### William Ripley

In 1638 William Ripley, with his wife and two sons and two daughters, came from Hingham, Norfolk County, England, and settled in Hingham, Mass. His original residence in England cannot be determined, but it is known that he went to Hingham for the special purpose of joining the company of emigrants who met there to sail for America.

Was admitted a freeman May 18, 1642. The house of one of his living descendants stands on the town lot deeded to him in Hingham Centre in 1638.

Their children were born in England, and were:
