Item I give and bequeath unto Susan Emmerton of Tryng aforesaid widd the somme of fifty shillings to be paid to her within sixe monthes after my decease. All the rest of my goodes Cattles and chattles & personall estate not herein given and disposed of, my debts and Legacies herein given paid and my sun'all chardges defrayed I give unto the said Lawrance Washington the young' my Godsonne whom I make sole and whole executo' of this my last Will and Testam' And I earnestly desire John Dagnall of Grove within the parish of Tryng aforesaid yeoman John Lake of Willst'ne aforesaid Gent' & the said Wilkin Roades and Elizabeth Fitzherbert to take upon them (for the sole benefitt & behoofe of the said Lawrance Washing' myne Executo') The adm'istracion of my goodes & Chattles during the minoritye of the said Lawrance Washing' & to see the due pformance of this my said Will, And I doe give unto them Tenn shillings a peece All former Wills by me made I doe heerby Revoake & repeale and declare this to be my last Will and Testament.
