John James King, born 1 Oct. 1839; died 10 April 1844. Edward Watson King, born 30 June 1841; bapt. at St. Peter's, Maidstone; entered the Mercantile Marine at an early age in the service of Charles Ellis and Co., and being in command of their vessels when 21. He was drowned in the Bay of Biscay when in command of steamship "Cortes," owned by McAndrew and Co., four only of the crew surviving (see Daily Papers for 12 Jan. 1875), his death happening, it is supposed, 16 Dec. 1874. Annie Elizabeth, dau. of Henry Saunders Edwards of Allington, co. Dorset, by his wife and cousin Lucinda Ruth Edwards (who were married at St. Mary's Abchurch, London, 1846), and a granddaughter of James Edwards and Thomas Edwards on her father's and mother's side respectively, the latter being of Redlands, Bristol, and who had to wife Miss Proctor Baker of the Quakeress family of that city. The aforesaid Annie Elizabeth was born 15 May 1847, bapt. at Greenwich Parish Church 9 June following, and married at Lewisham Old Church 23 June 1870, and resided at Elliot Place, Blackheath.

Harold Edward King, born 16 April 1871; educated at Christ's Hospital; of 31 Montpelier Vale, Blackheath.

Knowles King, born 12 Oct. 1872; died young.

Cathleen Carey King, born 23 July 1875; of 31 Montpelier Vale, Blackheath.

Richard Henry Hopwood King, born 14 June 1843; died 9 Sep. 1843.

Francis George King, born 7 Dec. 1844; died Sep. 1850.

William Louis King, born 8 Feb. 1847; bapt. at St. Peter's, Maidstone; educated at London University; Medical Officer in H.M.'s Prisons of Dartmoor and Portsmouth 1871-1873, after of Watlington, co. Norfolk, 1879-1895. (*Hoc Fecit.*)

Ellen Mary King, born 29 Jan. 1849; bapt. and married at St. Peter's 2 Jan. 1877; of Great Malvern.

William Henry Dawson, Physician, of St. Helen's, Great Malvern, died 10 Feb. 1895. One of two sons of Richard Dawson of Exeter, of whom the Rev. Benjamin Smith Dawson, his brother, was Rector of Hempstead, co. Gloucester, and married to Theresa, dau. of Sir James Cochrane, Chief Justice of Gibraltar, and died 1898, leaving issue.

Thomas William Hulkes King, born 16 April 1851; died Jan. 1854.

Bernard Watson King, born 23 June 1853; educated at Malvern College; a Solicitor at Cardiff, after of Hastings, and subsequently returned to Cardiff; living at Penarth.

Martha Jaue, dau. of John Thomas Edwards by his wife *nee* . . . Loveless; married at St. Andrew's, Cardiff, 25 April 1883.

Oswald Henry Dawson, born 9 March 1882; a Midshipman in the Navy on board H.M.S. "Empress of India."
