Richard Hopwood, born 1790; a hop and seed merchant of 29 Clifton Street, Finsbury Square; resided at Islington, and subsequently retired to Plymouth, where he died in 1860. Elizabeth Anne, dau. of Richard King of Offham, co. Kent; born 1785; bur. at Plymouth 1873. (See KING FAMILY.)
