William Hughes of Mersham, Kent. Administration of his property granted 25 Oct. 1726 to Ann Hughes the relict in the Archdeaconry Court of Canterbury, the bondsmen being Philip Usher of Great Chart, Yeoman, John Hughes of Great Chart in 1700. Ann, dau. of Usher.
