


Pedigree of Plane or Playne, co. Kent, shewing Henham descent.

Wyat Plane of Hadlow, co. Kent. He devised estates in Hadlow and East Peckham by will, proved in the Consistory Court of Rochester 15 Dec. 1597. Half-a-dozen deeds of his were mentioned in catalogue of Twysden Muniments, sold by Messrs. Sotheby in the Larkin sale 7 April 1892. (See APPENDIX.)



Thomas Plane, buried at East Peckham. Will proved in Croydon Peculiars 1634, wherein he mentions his "loving brother George Children of Tonbridge." Margaret, dau. of . . . Children, married at Tonbridge 1605. Her brother George had married a dau. of . . . Streatfield of Chiddingstone (Berry's "Kent"). The Children family were of "Childrens" in Hildenborough and Ramhurst in Lygh, and a descendant was High Sheriff of the county in 1698. It would appear that the Iden descent of the Henhams came from her family, for which see Philpott's "Kent," and Hasted's MSS. at the British Museum (Add. MS. 5520). See also will of George Children of Sevenoaks (Prerogative Court of Canterbury, 1595), mentioning nieces Margaret, Amye, Elizabeth, and Mary, daus. of John of Borne Place, the elder.
