


Pedigree entered : West Herington, cy. Durham.

The Rev. John Punshon, of this line, was fellow of Queen's College, Oxford, in 1551; and presented to the Vicarage of Newbold-on-Avon, Warwickshire, in 1554.⁷⁶

⁷⁶ In the fourteenth century John Pynchard held lands in Middle Herington; but this name may be a variant of "Pinchard" which appears early in Durham: notably in the Bolden Buke, the first survey of the county.
