

LINCOLNSHIRE.

Sir Roger de Punchardon was enfeoffed in this county in 1165 ; also Oliver, at Navenesby, in 1216.⁸³ They belonged to the Hampshire family ; and other members of it were concerned with Lincoln from time to time. Among them was Richard de Punchardon,⁸⁴ who held lands at Cateby, and the manor of Haylesthorne. He was a jurator for the Wapentake at Southesk, in Lindesay, where he had half a knight's fee under Elias de Rabeyn. *Inquisitio post mortem* was made of his feoffs in 1298. Walter his son succeeded.

John Ponchard held half the manor of Rason, in 1372.⁸⁵
