*(Curia Arch: Totnes: Exeter.)***Wills.****Thomas Punchard, of Dartmouth, goldsmith.**

To forty poor people of Totnes, sixpence each. Anstace, his wife, to have the estates and chattels specified in marriage settlement. Each grandchild twenty shillings. Sister Johan Punchard three pounds. Arthur Harvie of Totnes, son-in-law, and John his son, to hold lands in Totnes and Dartington, late in the occupation of Hugh White, miller, in trust for his three sons equally: namely Francis Punchard (on his return from beyond seas), the said John Punchard, and Henry Punchard; with remainder to two sons of said Francis, namely Francis and Thomas Punchard. Mentions lease of a house in Staverton. Arthur Harvie and John Punchard, executors.

Dated Dec: 4, 1669. Proved 23 Apl: 1675. Sum total of Inventory, £60.

Richard Punchard, of Totnes, vyntner.

To son, Lewis Punchard, clothes, &c. To sister, Joan Punchard, twenty shillings; to grandchild, Mary Jones, forty shillings; to servant, Bridget Payne, five pounds; and to rest of household five shillings each. Wife Joan. To son, Richard, twelvecence. Daughter, Mary Jones, executrix & residuary legatee.

Dated 4 Dec: 1671. Proved 12 Nov: 1675. Inventory of "personals," £13.10.

Richard Punchard, of Totnes, goldsmith.

Unto Dorothy Punchard, my deare wife, all lands, messuages, and tenements for^s life. But, if she faile to pay debts, I give the same unto my deare brother, Lewes Punchard, and Robert Kelligrew of Totnes, my good friend, to be sold; profit to remaine unto Hugh Punchard, my sonne. Said Hugh to pay unto Thomas Webber, sonne of William Webber, thirtye pounds. If said Hugh Punchard leave noe issue, then I doe give all said premises unto Henry Punchard, my sonne, and the heires of his body, chargeable with sums of money as follows—unto Dorothy Brockwell, wife of George Brockwell, John Webber and Thomas Webber, sons of William Webber, fiftie pounds apiece. Unto Isaac Punchard, sonne of said Lewes my brother, ten pounds; unto Joan, his daughter, five pounds. To my son, Zachary Punchard, twelvecence. To my daughter, Joane, wife of Peter Harvy, twelvecence. To my sister, Mary Jones, ten shillings.

Hugh Punchard, to be sole executor; Lewes Punchard and Robert Kelligrew to be trustees and guardians to said sonne Hugh, duringe his minority.

Dated 3 Dec: 1675. Proved 15 Apl, 1676. Codicil appointing Isaac Punchard, "sonne of Lewes my brother", in remainder, to all the estate, proved also same date.
