Son, **John**, to whom he gives house called "Packe's tenement", meadow called "Eades" parcell of land called "Jakes"; son, **Jeremie**, to whom he gives land in Occold; son, **William**, piece of land called "Mellpost", pyghtell called "Eglingtons", piece called "Shortplots", Newgate pyghtell, and Copbushe pyghtell, in Bedingfield, Executor: brother **John**.

Dated 20 Oct: 1634. Proved 11 May, 1637.

Thomas Punchard. Bedingfield, yeoman.

Wife, **Sarah**; father-in-law, **Rooke**, executor.

Dated 18 July, 1682. Proved 3 Sept: 1682.

George Punchard. Henley, yeoman.

Wife, **Katherine**; kinsmen, **George Hayles** and **James Hayles**, son of **William Hayles** of Henley, yeoman; **George Punchard**, son of brother **Edmund Punchard** of **Witnesham**; friend, **William Smyth** of **Blakenham**, miller, executor.

Dated 20 June, 1696. Proved 29 Aug: 1696.

John Punchard. Easton, maltster.

Sons, **John** and **James**; daughters, **Rachel** and **Sybilla**; wife, **Rachel**; brother-in-law, **Francis Peachey** of **Buttley**, executor.

Dated 21 Feb: 1698-9. Proved 30 Mar: 1699.

George Punchard. Witnesham.

Wife, **Thomasin**; house and lands wherein **Robert Pinner** lives, lying in **Witnesham** and **Tuddenham**; father, **Edmund Punchard**, **William Hailes**, son of **Ann Hailes**, sister of testator; and **George Hailes**, his brother, executors.

Dated 22 Aug: 1688. Proved 26 July, 1701.

Thomazine Punchard. Grandisburgh, widow.

Sister, **Mary Wilkin**. Legacies to **Thomas Cockrill** of **Clopton**, yeoman, and **Elizabeth**, his wife; **Edward Boone** of **Witnesham**; **Susan**, wife of **John Page**, **Elizabeth Cutting**, and **Thomasin**, wife of **Robert Bright**.

Dated 12 July, 1704. Proved 19 July, 1704.

John Punchard. Hacheston, gentleman.

Son, **John**; daughter, **Mary**, lands in **Peasenhall**; daughter, **Rachael**; granddaughter, **Mary Button**; brother-in-law, **Thomas Folkard** of **Aldburgh**, supervisor.

Dated 22 Oct: 1755. Proved 25 Nov: 1756.

John Punchard. Saxtead, gentleman.

Son, **John Baldrey Punchard**, lands in **Peasenhall**, in occupation of **James Cleveland**; wife, **Ann**; son, **James**, the estate of **John Punchard**, the testator's late father, in **Saxtead**; daughter, **Mary**, lands in **Monk Soham**, in occupation of **Thomas Hatcher**; daughters, **Ann** and **Lucy**, lands in **Saxtead**. Executors: Friend, **Benjamin Baldrey** of **Earl Soham**, gentleman; and sister **Mary Welham**, wife of **John Welham**, of **Stratford St. Andrew**.

Dated 23 Jan: 1774. Proved 7 Dec: 1787.
