Divine Chatfield of Oxford became a member of Morning Star Lodge, F. & A. M., June 28, 1809.

Benjamin I. Chatfield and Sarah E. Judd of Bethany were married Dec. 11, 1848.—(Christ Church Records.)

Dolly Chatfield, aged 56, was buried in Episcopal churchyard, Bethany, Nov. 10, 1840.

Frederick N. Chatfield enlisted from Seymour, Sept. 2, 1861, in Co. E, 7th C. V., and he was one of the 333 original members of the regiment who re-enlisted as veterans in December, 1863. He continued in the service until the close of the war and was mustered out July 20, 1865.

Geo. A. Chatfield enlisted in Co. D, 2d Regt.; April 23, 1861, for three months, and was mustered out Aug. 7th. He re-enlisted from Seymour, Sept. 2, 1861, in Co. E, 7th C. V., re-enlisted as a veteran Dec. 22, 1863; was promoted corporal June 22, 1864; mustered out July 20, 1865.
