"The Book of Family Crests," Vol. II, describes the Chatfield crests as follows:

CHATFIELD, a demi-moor, with a quiver on his back, shooting an arrow from a bow, all ppr.

CHATFIELD, an heraldic antelope's head erased, ar., ducally gorged, or.

———— Suss., an antelope's head erased, ar., horned and ducally gorged, gn.

"Patronymica Britannica" says of the origin of the name Chatfield, "A locality which is not identified, but apparently near Lewes, Sussex."
