3 My will is and I do give to my son Stephen Coffin to him his heirs and assigns all my housing and upland and meadows with privileges of Common Rights belonging to me in hauerhill, and all my meadow within the bounds of M<sup>r</sup> Hookes farme, and all my meadow at Plumb Island at the North end of the Island called the hundred acres: and one fift part of Common Rights in Newbury: and one fift part of my free hold lots, and one third part of the Rate lot I bought of Joseph Plumer, he paying to his son Tristram five pounds

4 My will is I give to my son Peter Coffin to him his heirs and assigns for ever the farm at Glostar with the Island and all privileges in Common within the township of Glostar the which I have given him a deed of: and I gave him six shillings and I do hereby order my said son Peter Coffin: to pay to his brother Nathaniel Coffin all that is due to me from him either by book bill, or bond: and the 6<sup>th</sup> a year that my wife should receive of him annually, during her natural life because my son Nathaniel must provide for his mother.

5: My will is and I do give to my son Nathaniel Coffin to him, his heirs and assigns my now dwelling house with my barns and pasture land adjoining and archards so much front as from Richard Browns land to half way the cow yard: between the barns: and two parts of five of all Common Rights in Newbury and all my plowland adjoining to Joseph Downers land: and the one half of my archard and pasture land at Trotters bridge and one half of the wood land I bought of Edmond Moore: and the one half of my Rate lot at Emaris meadow: including my son James is .6. acres as part of it: and the one third part of the Rate lot I bought of Joseph Plumer, and 2 parts of five of my free hold lots: and that Rate lot that I bought of Hugh March and Hains, by John Browns upper house adjoining to the land Peter Coffin bought of John Bartlet and all my meadow at Little Pin Island, and all the .6. acres I bought of Nath Badger, and all the meadow, bought of the longes of Danil Osolloway: excepting the .4. acres given to James: and half the meadow I bought of Parsifell Lowle: and all the meadow at JeRecow one the north east side of the creek, and fower lots at Plumb Island of meadow: Wheelers lot and Smith .2. lots and Grenlef lot: and the one half of the wood lot lately laid out lying between Richard Browns and docker Toppans: as also all my household goods and cattle and sheep: and swine and harts and all other things belonging to me and all my debts due to me by book bills and bonds or other wise.

6. My will is I give to my grand son Tristram Sambrook: fower pounds to be paid to him by his father out of the money I lent him to by meadow with, and the Remainder I give to my daughter Judith.

7 Itam I give to my daughter Deborah Knight 5<sup>l</sup> and: twelve walnut trees: In that land I bought of Edmond Moores: and to her son Tristram Knight a cowe.
