JOHN WEBSTER¹ came from Ipswich, Suffolk County, England, to Ipswich, Massachusetts, where he was made a freeman in 1635. He died soon after coming here, leaving four sons and four daughters. The family subsequently moved to Newbury. The names of the children are given below, but not in the order of their birth, for the dates of their birth are not recorded.
