NATHAN WEBSTER⁵ resided on the old homestead in Chester. His wife was Elizabeth, daughter of Isaac Clifford of Candia, New Hampshire, and granddaughter of William Healy. Isaac Clifford was the son of Samuel Clifford of Kingston, New Hampshire, and Martha Healy, his wife, was the daughter of William and Mary (Sanborn) Healy, formerly of Hampton Falls. MOSES WEBSTER⁵ moved to Hartland, Vermont, and took up two lots of wild land of which he made a farm that is still occupied by his descendants. He married in Hartland, about 1780, Elizabeth Woods, and died October 11, 1844, aged 90, and his wife died in 1837 aged 87.
