

John Sikes, my first child, was borne at y^e blind beggar's house at Bethnall Green in Midd^xsex fryday y^e 5th of October about 6 oth' clock in y^e morning 1688 & baptized in y^e same house thursday 25th same month in y^e afternoon by Thos. Cole in presence of Moth^r Ashe Uncle & Aunt Walton B^r & S^r Ashe B^r & S^r Standcliffe* B^r Jn^o Ashe S^r Dale S^r Hannah &c.

Memorand^m my son John went to School & board with B^r Haynes at Bednall Green y^e 9th day of September 1695 at p' an'um

Gobert Sikes my 2^d was born at my house in Well Street in Hackney Parish the thirtieth of November 1689 being Saterdag about 2 oth' clock afternoon & baptized there by M^r. Thomas Cole on fryday 13th of December same year before dinner.

Thomas my third child was borne at my house in Well Street Hackney Tuesday y^e 5th of April 1692 at twelve o'clock at noon & baptized there by M^r Thomas Cole on fryday 22^d same month before noon.

Elizabeth my fourth child was born at my house in Well Street Hackney Saterdag o'clock in y^e morning being y^e 24th of february 1692 & there baptized by M^r Thomas Cole on fryday 28^d March following at 8 oth' clock afternoone.

Mary my 5th child was borne at my new house in Well Street Hackney on y^e Lord's day half an' houre after 11 at night being y^e 22th of June 1701 & baptiz'd in same house by M^r Rob^t Billis on Wensday 2^d of July following in y^e forenoon.

Gobert Sikes & Ann Hill were marryed at S^t Thomas Hospitall in Southwark by M^r Mayo 12 7ber being Saterdag 1719.

Ann Sikes my First Child was borne in the Parish of S^t Michael Basishaw Tuesday y^e 14th June 1720 about one of the clock in y^e morn^s & baptized 1 July by the Rev^d D^r Roderick. Coz. J^{no} Holden Godfather Sister Hill & Mrs Dalton Godmothers.

John Sikes my Second child born at my house in Savage gardens Cutchid Fryers Saterdag 16 June 1722. Xtened by M^r Arrowsmith 22 June Brother Thos. Sikes & M^r John Thompson† Godfathers Aunt Hill Godm^r.

Thomas Sikes & Jane Robinson was marryed at Eastham Church in Essex 29th Sep^r 1726 by M^r Carter Vicker of Lowlayton.

My first child Eliz^a Sikes was Borne at my house in Marke lane Sunday night y^e 6 day August 1727: and chrisned by M^r Parker Curat to D^r Arrowsmith of y^e Church in Crutched fryers. Cap. Franc^s Robinson Godfather Eliz^a Robinson & Sister Eliz^a Sikes Godmothers.

My 2^d child Tho^s Sikes was Borne in Marke lane at my house before mentioned Sunday morning 24 Feb. 1732 and Xn^d by D^r Arrowsmith Godfathers Papillon Ball & Denham Hamond† Godm^r Sister Mary Sikes.

My 3^d child Jane Sikes was Borne in Water Gruel row in Hackney Monday night first March 1742 and chris^t by D^r Wright Vicker of Hackney Godfather Papillon Ball Godmothers Sis^r Eliz^a Ball & daughter Eliz^a Sikes.

Elizabeth Sikes daughter of the aforesaid Thomas and Jane was married to Henry Sawbridge§ 9 October 1752 at the parish Church of S^t Stephⁿ albrook by the Rev. M^r Jn^o Lewis.
