14 Feb: 1609—I Peter Winder, curate & minister of Witchurch, Oxford—make my Will—Give to Poor of Winfell (Cumberland) where I was born 10/—To Lorton School, 40/—To Peter Wilkinson my sister's son, born in Looswater £10—To Joan Deny my sister's youngest daughter £12, to Isabell £5...To Robert Winder, son of my brother Mathew £5—To Cuthbert\* my brother's son £3... To Peter Winder my cousin, who is apprenticed to Rich<sup>d</sup>. Whetstone, £10—Both my brethren dwell in Cumberland.
